Check the tour options for tourists arriving by ship in Paranaguá. Embark on this adventure along the coast of Paraná too!

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
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#### **SEA, SAND AND INCREDIBLE MOMENTS**










Morretes, Antonina and Guaraqueçaba are historical cities with rich colonial and lots of adventure!

In addition to fresh seafood, there is barreado, a typical dish of the state, roasted grey mullet, the famous Paraná oysters and Cambira (smoked fish). ### **UNFORGETTABLE TRAIN TOURS**

From the capital Curitiba, it is possible to go to the coast by road or by train (Serra Verde Express), which runs along a century-old railway through Serra do Mar, considered one of the most beautiful train rides in the world. Take a trip back in the time aboard heritage steam train between Morretes and Antonina, the Caicara Train (a 1.5 hours train ride) provides enchanting moments in the Atlantic Forest.
